We truly believe this is a way to reach young people before they fall into destructive behaviors that can cause mental health issues that can lead to suicide.

The Mommy Shoppe is a fully stocked store that we provide for teen parents to shop for their child. “Mommy Bucks” are the only currency used to make purchases in the Mommy Shoppe. These bucks are earned through completing lessons through a program called BrightCourse. The Mommy Shoppe offers baby supplies, such as activity or play centers, bassinets, bibs, blankets, bouncy seats, carriers, car seats, changing tables, clothes (new and gently used), cribs, diaper bags, diapers, wipes, formula, highchairs, shoes, socks, jackets, gloves, strollers, swings and more.
